WHAT IS A LIVING-LEARNING COMMUNITY?

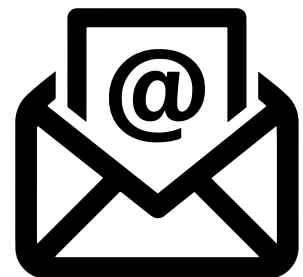
Living Learning Communities (LLCs) were created to provide students with the opportunity to experience the transition to a larger university in smaller, more personal groups. They are designed to assist in the academic transition to university instruction, to support the student-faculty interaction beyond the classroom, and to encourage positive student connections within East Carolina University.

Students that reside in a learning community take at least two classes together in the Fall semester. Research shows that students that reside in these special living communities tend to have higher grade point averages than other students, and their retention rate towards graduation from the university is much higher than students not living in these communities.

HOW TO APPLY FOR A LLC?

Each LLC at East Carolina University is unique in their focus and theme. Every LLC has different requirements and a different contact person. Here are overall points to keep in mind...

- First, you must complete your Campus Living Housing contract.
- Next, you must complete the application/process for the Living-Learning Community of your choice. All of which can be found on the Campus Living website under the Living-Learning Communities tab.
- Once you have been accepted to ECU, an admittance packet and your ECU e-mail account details will be mailed to you. This account and password will give you access to the Pirate Port web site for the online contracting process.
- Please work with the departments and/or individuals listed for that LLC for your application approval.
