Success Learning Community students:

- ✓ Report higher feelings of campus belonging and academic support.
- ✓ Use tutoring services at higher rates than non-LC students.
- ✓ Are more likely to complete successfully in comparison to their freshmen peers.
- ✓ Earn higher 4-year graduation rates in comparison to campus peers.

The greatest strength of the Success Learning Community is in the relationships built between students and staff through peer, faculty, and academic engagement activities that connect LC students to ECU in meaningful ways.
