August 7th from 9 am to 3 pm

DROP-OFF PROCEDURES

- You have 2 hours to move items in, then please make way for other Pirates to maximize their drop-off window
 - Return to campus after 4 pm on August 22nd or later
 - No fee or charge

PRIMARY MOVE-IN TIMES

You will receive a designated Move-In date and time. This will be specific to each residence hall and floor.

Thursday, August 21st

Friday, August 22nd

You will receive this in your assignment email.

OTHER MOVE-IN OPTIONS

**If your Designated Move-In Time does not work,
we have other options:**

You may arrive any time after your designated move-in time on your building's move-in day until 4pm

We also have After-Hour and Weekend Options:

After-Hour Arrivals: August 20th, 21st, 22nd at your NSO, 7-10 pm

Weekend Arrivals: August 23rd & 24th at your NSO, 9am-10pm

MOVE-IN TIPS

- We will have some carts/handcarts to help during Drop-Off and Move-In, however, **the best cart to have during Move-In is the one you bring yourself!**



MOVE-IN REMINDERS

- Your assignment will be sent to your ECU email by early July.
- Refer to your room assignment email for your designated move-in date and time, specific to your assigned building and floor
- You may receive different Move-In information from your LLC or special groups, if you do, please follow those instructions
- You may arrive any time after your assigned move-in time on your building's move-in day
 - Students who participated in Drop-Off need to return to campus after 4 pm on August 22nd or later



THE FINE PRINT

- Remember that the university is not responsible for your valuable items, so please consider:
 - Not bringing overly expensive items to campus
 - Reviewing home-owner policies to see if the student dorm is covered, and if not...
 - Consider renters insurance

- 1 Cards are used to access Residence Halls and meal plans.
- Students: Apply for your 1Card and upload your picture if you haven't already. Do this ASAP! This is VERY important to ensure you have your 1 Card when you return to campus in August to Move-In.

AIR QUALITY IN YOUR ROOM

ECU is aware of increasing attention to air quality nationwide

- Mold is in all environments. We prevent growth by focusing on air circulation & humidity levels.
- Protocol for concerns start with a work request, addressed by Campus Living, Environmental Health, and Facilities.
 - AC units are cleaned on a schedule that depends on the unit type.
 - Just like at home, you can expect to see a buildup of dust on filters and grills over time. This shows the filter is working properly.
 - More info on the AC/Heat unit in your room is provided at Move-In.

SAFETY IN YOUR ROOM

Building Security

- All building entrances are locked 24/7
- All building entrances are equipped with cameras
 - No piggybacking building entrances
